





Yummy Sudoku

Cut the pictures and paste them to complete Sudoku.

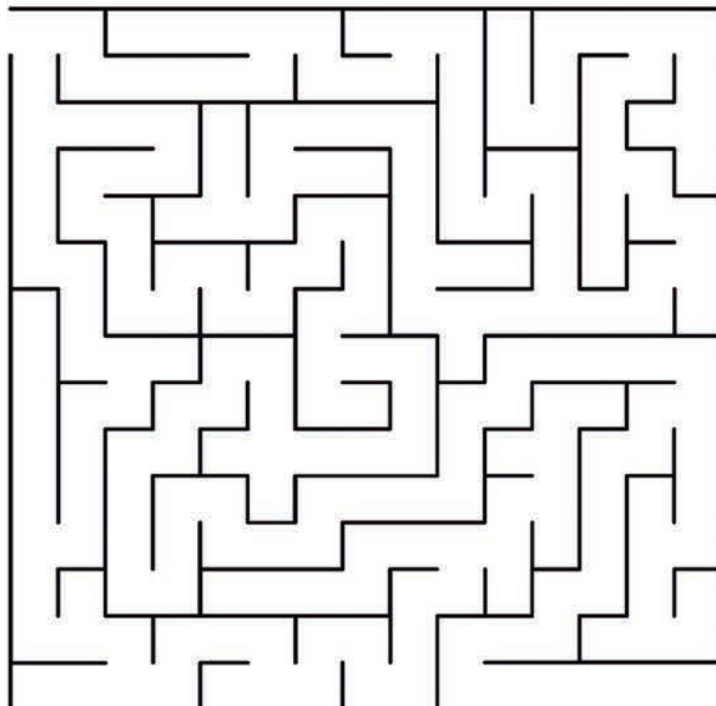

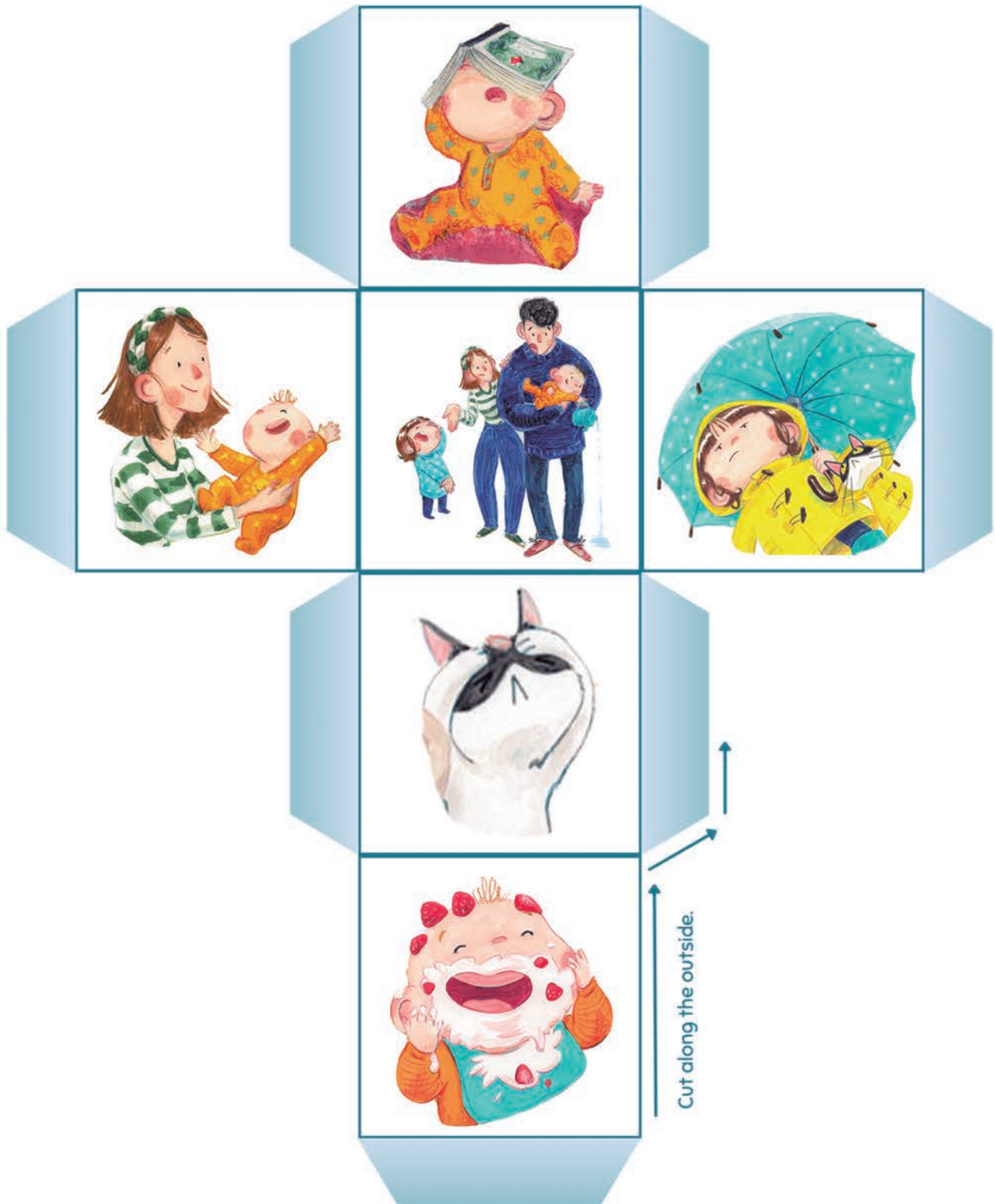
